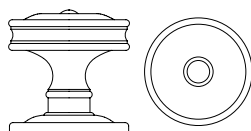

The N° 1438 drum knob is a synthesis of traditional Georgian forms. A flat ring distinguishes the boss at the center from the ogival face of the knob. The drum-like shape, delineated by two astragals reflected across a cavetto profile, surmounts the contoured shank. The ogee and astragal motif is repeated in the round rose. Full mortise entry locks, privacy locks, passage latches and tubular latches may be provided for use with this knob. All Nanz plated and patinated finishes are available.
