


## Nº 6025

 $The \ No \ 6025 \ recessed \ pull \ is \ robustly \ functional \ yet \ handsomely \ proportioned \ and \ detailed. \ The \ gently \ swelling \ penannular \ handle \ is$ attached to a straight horizontal bar. Gaining popularity throughout the 20th century, the pull's pragmatic design is reminiscent of nautical hardware. The No 6025 is also available with a drop ring, keyhole cutout, or thumbturn. It is frequently specified for use with Harmon hinge doors. The face has four exposed screws. All plated and patinated finishes are available.
