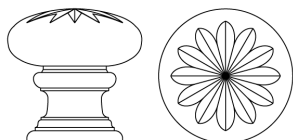




N° 1124C

Fine crystal handles gained popularity in the late 19th century and have since been a symbol of refinement and elegance in the home. The N° 1124C bears a smooth round crystal knob with a starburst cut. It is hand cast and polished using the same manufacturing techniques used in the 1880s. The interior of the crystal is mirrored and bezel-set in the columnar shank which is encircled by the simple ring of the rose. A variety of alternative rose designs with varying degrees of decoration are also available. The knob is available in all plated and patinated finishes and can be supplied for either full mortise sets or tubular latches if preferred. A minimum order is required.
