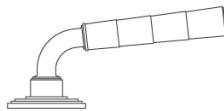
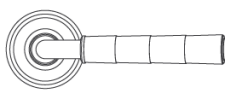

The No 2064 lever was inspired by an American Art Deco design of the 1930s. The overall outward flare softens the strict geometry of the stepped handle. The lever is adaptable to a variety of interiors, depending on the choice of finish; polished nickel, satin nickel and chrome, for example, emphasize the modernity of the design, while burnished brass and patinated finishes produce a more traditional appearance.
