The double ball catch is used to secure swinging cabinet doors. The catch is secured on the inside of the cabinet, and fully concealed from view when the cabinet is closed. Without a visible strike, this is ideal for maintaining clean lines on cabinet faces. The tension is adjustable to ensure the proper feel. The catch should be installed horizontally at the bottom of the cabinet. The small catch is $\frac{5}{16}$ " x $1 \frac{13}{16}$ " for use on small cabinets, and is also available in a medium $2 \frac{1}{8}$ " x $\frac{7}{16}$ " size for standard cabinets. Brass and Chrome finishes are available.
