 $The \ N^o \ 8204S \ cabinet \ knob \ was \ of ten \ used \ in \ Neoclassical \ Park \ Avenue \ apartment \ buildings \ of \ the \ 1920s. \ A \ straight \ knurl$ complements the ogee face and torus edge of the knob, which is also available with a beaded, roped knurl or plain astragal. The shallow cove of the shank is echoed in the edge of the optional rosette, which is available at an additional cost. It is often specified with the  $companion\ N^{\circ}\ 1204\ knob, which is\ manufactured\ in\ a\ variety\ of\ sizes\ for\ full-sized\ doors.\ All\ Nanz\ plated\ and\ patinated\ finishes\ are$ available.
